Planting Guide:

Roses perform best in the full sun. When planting, choose a well-drained location in your garden that receives full sun at least 6 hours per day. Follow the appropriate planting instructions below.

Dig a hole larger than the pot size. Carefully remove plant from container, keeping soil ball intact. Place plant in hole at proper height: bud union at ground level in mild climates-below ground level in cold areas. Fill in around root ball with soil mix. Tamp down lightly and water well to remove air pockets. Add more soil if necessary. Build a water basin around plant to assist in watering. Apply a 2-3" layer of mulch to conserve moisture and prevent weeds.
